727 SUPPORT SERVICES GOALS

Support services are essential to the successful function of a school system. Management of auxiliary operations is, therefore, an important responsibility of the School District administration. It should be remembered, however, that education is the School District's central function, and all support services shall be provided, guided, and evaluated by this requirement.

In order to provide support services that are truly supportive of the educational program, the Board establishes these broad goals:

- A. To provide a physical environment for teaching and learning that is safe and pleasant for students, staff and public.
- B. To provide safe transportation for students to and from school and nutritious meals for students.
- C. To provide support services, resources and assistance with maximum responsiveness in terms of timeliness and degree of fulfillment of the needs of the educational program as they develop.
