

729 SAFETY PROGRAM

Accidents are undesirable, unplanned occurrences that may result in tragic consequences – bodily harm, loss of school time, property damage, legal action, and even fatality. It shall be the policy of the Board to guard against such occurrences by taking every possible precaution to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on School District property or at school sponsored events.

The practice of safety shall also be considered a facet of the instructional plan of the School District schools by virtue of educational programs in traffic and pedestrian safety, driver education, fire prevention, emergency procedures, etc., appropriately geared to students at different grade levels.

Each building principal shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school. General areas of emphasis shall include, but not be limited to: in-service training, plant inspection, driver education, fire prevention, emergency procedures, and traffic safety.
