

104 SCHOOL DISTRICT VISION AND MISSION STATEMENTS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a clear statement of the purpose for which the school district exists.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The school board believes that a vision statement and a mission statement should be adopted. The vision statement and the mission statement should be based on the beliefs and values of the community should direct any change effort and should be the basis on which decisions are made. The school board, on behalf of and with extensive participation by the community, should develop a consensus among its members regarding the nature of the enterprise the school board governs, the purposes it serves, the constituencies it should consider, including student representation, and the results it intends to produce.

III. VISION STATEMENT

School District 593, as an education destination, will create a community where all individuals will strive to reach their full potential in academics, co-curriculars, and as productive citizens in a diverse and global society.

IV. MISSION STATEMENT

Understanding that the student is the focal point of our mission, we will educate students to become lifelong learners and respectful, caring individuals within the fiscal resources available. Crookston Public Schools will involve family, other community members and organizations to create a positive learning environment.

V. REVIEW

The school board will review the school district's mission every two years, when members of the board change. The school board will conduct a comprehensive review of the mission, including the beliefs and values of the community, every five to seven years.
