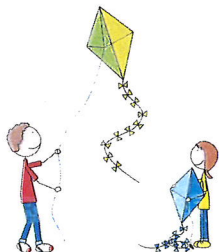
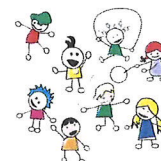

Summer Care Rules:

We have implemented a plan for student behavior during Summer Care. Following are the procedures in the event there are inappropriate or unacceptable student behaviors that we have attempted to resolve. In the School Age Care Handbook on page 3, the process for behavior management is outlined. It is our goal to promote a positive approach with all children in the management of behavior. The following discipline plan will be implemented if we are unable to resolve the inappropriate and unacceptable behaviors. Please review this plan with your child/children.

The following steps will be implemented:

1. The first incident will result in a phone call or conversation with parents to notify them of the student behavior that warranted parent contact.
2. The second incident will result in the student being picked up as soon as possible from Summer Care for the rest of the day.
3. The third incident will result in the student being picked up as soon as possible and removed from Summer Care for the rest of the day and two additional days.
4. The fourth incident will result in the student being picked up as soon as possible and the student may no longer be able to attend Summer Age Care.

Note: Steps may be omitted due to the severity of the incident or incidences.
